CCPCS fills a few different roles in the CTA's Capital Program. The schedulers are responsible for performing planning and scheduling functions such as project schedule development, critical path analysis, reporting, and performing schedule reviews during the design and construction phases. The schedulers also independently develop, evaluate and update resource loaded schedules for maintenance, renovation, and rehabilitation of major complex transportation projects. CCPCS is also responsible for creating and maintaining the document control system. Our staff writes and implements procedures and guidelines to organize all project documents in a central electronic location and assists with the project close out.

Our Technical Administrative staff assists in assembling consultant contracts, reviewing and verifying invoices, and other administrative tasks.
